EASTER SUNDAY OF THE LORD’S RESURRECTION

STAY @ HOME EASTER CELEBRATION

This year we celebrate Easter as a domestic family in the confines of our homes in unity with the bigger church at large. At the same time we continue to stay safe at home. As we move into Holy Thursday and Good Friday, kindly use the suggestions put forward in last weeks’ bulletin. Please refer to live streaming broadcasted schedule on Tv.archkl.org

Here are some suggestions to assist you to participate on Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday, from the comfort of your homes.

HOLY SATURDAY

1. Pray the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary anytime during the day OR Unplug from all audio-visual gadgets for an hour anytime during the day to experience a period of “Darkness”. Eg., disengage from browsing the internet, social media, game console, etc.
2. Make a family Paschal Candle – Decorate a new family paschal candle. A new tea-light candle in a decorated glass would be a good alternative. (Keep safe.) Uncover/re-decorate your family altar and place the family paschal candle on it before the start of the Mass.
3. Participate in the live streaming Mass online at the timing given by the diocese at TV.Archkl.org
4. Conclude the Easter Vigil celebration with a thanksgiving prayer and meal to celebrate the victory of Christ’s resurrection. Place a clear bowl of water on a white cloth/napkin in the center of the table to remind ourselves of our baptism into new life in Christ.
5. Snap close up photos of the family Paschal Candle and share it with your family/friends in the BEC/parish to mark your family Easter.
6. Contact your BEC members on an online platform the next day and share your experience with them of the significance this year’s Stay @ Home Holy Week Journey.

EASTER SUNDAY

1. Prepare a basket of colourfully decorated Easter eggs and place them on the family dining table. Alternatively, children may draw pictures of Easter eggs and display them around the house.
2. Uncover/re-decorate your family altar and if you have made a family paschal candle, place the family paschal candle on the altar before the start of the live streaming Mass online.
3. Participate in the live streaming Mass online at the timing given by the diocese at TV.Archkl.org
4. Conclude the Easter Sunday morning celebration with a meal to celebrate the victory of Christ’s resurrection. Place a clear bowl of water on a white cloth/napkin in the centre of the table to remind ourselves of our baptism into new life in Christ. Alternatively, the basket of colourfully decorated Easter eggs at the table/pictures of the Easter eggs adorning the house also depict the new life in abundance.
5. Snap close up photos of your family paschal candle and/or bowl of water and/or Easter egg basket/drawing of the Easter eggs and share it with family/friends in the BEC/parish to mark your family Easter.
6. Contact your BEC members on an online platform after your Easter fellowship and share your experience with them the significance this year’s Stay @ Home Holy Week Journey.
