#### THE DIOCESAN PHASE (OCT 2021 – APRIL 2022)

This phase is to consult the people of God, to carry the synodal process through “Listening to all the baptized” who as the Second Vatican Council said “cannot err in matters of belief”



The Parish level Synodal team has chosen three themes (1) Listening (2) Speaking Out (3) Forming Ourselves in Synodality. In our preparation we are called to hear and listen to Jesus through the scripture based on (1) Mat 15: 21-28 – The Canaanite Women; (2) John 4: 5-14 – The Samaritan Women; (3) John 9 – The Man born Blind

Each Ministry and BEC or groups are to go through and respond to each question related to the 3 focus themes. The questions have been forward to all leaders who will share with everyone.

#### WORLD DAY OF THE POOR – NOVEMBER 14<sup>th</sup> 2021

In conjunction with the Fourth World Day of the Poor. Pope Francis message is that “*The poor you will always have with you*” (Mk14:7) This shows that those who do not respect the poor betray Jesus’ teaching and cannot be his disciples.

Jesus reminds us that he is the first of the poor, the poorest of the poor, because he represents all of them. The face of God revealed by Jesus is that of a Father concerned for and close to the poor. In everything, Jesus teaches that poverty is not the result of fate, but a concrete sign pointing to his presence among us.

We see him in the lives of the poor, in their sufferings and needs, in the often inhuman conditions in which they are forced to live.

The poor are not people “outside” our communities, but brothers and sisters whose sufferings we should share, in an effort to alleviate their difficulties and marginalization, restore their lost dignity and ensure their necessary social inclusion.

#### LATEST CHANCERY UPDATE ON PROTOCOLS ON MCO IMPLEMENTATION- PHASE 4

We continue to comply with the October 25<sup>th</sup> Chancery Notice, under the National Recovery Plan (NRP), which was issued for K.L and P.J. The Parish Response Team will continue to update us with any new recommendations.

1. **Weddings** during this period may resume with 1/3 capacity. All have to be fully vaccinated and pre-registered. Seat numbers are to be allocated to all attendees. the Parent.
  2. **Sacraments will continue with conditions applied.**
  3. **Funerals** will resume with 1/3 capacity with persons attending with pre-registration done with full vaccination. Seat numbers are to be allocated to all attendees.
  4. **Capacity** for Public Masses will not exceed 1/3 capacity of its pre MCO capacity.
  5. **Baptisms** are on hold except in the case of any emergency.

The last day to send your creative coin box to the church is by **14<sup>th</sup> November 2021**. The parish thanks all the children for sharing with the less fortunate children.

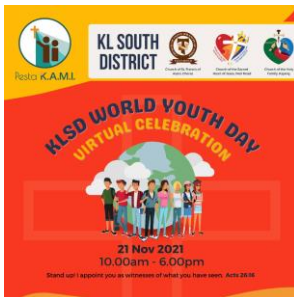
